INVITATION TO GARDEN PARTY:

Ten minutes after they arrived in the Palace Gardens they were approached by another lady and a gentleman who work for the Queen and asked if we would like to be presented to Her Majesty. This took the form of how to address the Queen and that she would be talking to us for three to five minutes. The conversation included how the RBLWS help finance equipment needed for ex-service personnel or their children to attend college through the President's Award Scheme. The ladies had a wonderful day but the icing on the cake was when the Queen and the Royal Party started to leave the gardens, she came across and started talking to Vera and her colleagues followed by HRH Prince Phillip, Prince Charles, Camilla and the Princess Eugene, who all shook their hands and asked if they had enjoyed the day. SURGERY NEWS - MISSED APPOINTMENTS:

Once again I have to report another disappointing month for missed appointments. It seems one month there is a reduction, then the following month an increase as the following figures show:

May, 2017 - 203 patients did not attend, an average of 50 per week: time wasted 50 hours

April, 2017 - 141 patients did not attend: an average of 35 per week: time wasted 34 hours

March, 2017 - 201 patients did not attend

Our surgery offers an appointment texting service. If you have a mobile phone, inform the receptionists who will text you the day prior to your appointment, hopefully this will limit the number of missed appointments.

PARTNERSHIP NEWS:

This month's Partnership meeting was held on Wednesday, 21st June, 2017 at 6.30 p.m. in the Community Centre. Before the meeting commenced, Linda PEARS, the Chair of the Partnership, said a few words about the sad news of Councillor Watts STELLING's wife, Yvonne and also Mrs. Vera HEWLETT, a member of the Leadgate Taskforce, the Partnership members offer their condolences to both families.

The meeting was informed Mrs. Jeanette HAROLD is to be co-ordinator with the Y.M.C.A. The Taskforce has a CPR dummy and is looking for storage space in order that it may link with the defibrillator scheme.

Groundwork have now been given the 'go ahead' to commence the work in Watling Wood, two seats are to be provided and also pond dipping facilities: boardwalk facilities have still be finalised. The money received from Tesco's 'Bags of Help' scheme is to be spent by September, 2017. A meeting is to be held to finalise the work and a written agreement to be made.

Durham County's 'Operation Spruce Up' will take place in Leadgate the first week in July, 2017, a list has been prepared as to what needs to be looked at, pavements and drainage being two of the things. On 4th July, 2017 a litter pick on the Sustrans C2C cycle track will take place between 10 am – 12 noon. Details will be published on Facebook and posters will be placed in various shops.

The question of possibly providing a one kilometre wood chip running track in Watling Wood was discussed, which was felt would be much healthier than having one on the road, unfortunately the Wood is very boggy in places and the question was raised 'How do you make it wheelchair friendly?'

The next meeting of the Partnership will be Wednesday, 19th July, 2017 at 6.30 p.m. in the Community Centre.



COUNCILLORS' REPORTS:

BRASS FESTIVAL:

Following last year's success where bands (who participated in the Durham Brass Festival) demonstrated/performed at Leadgate Primary (Upper and Lower) Schools, we have arranged a similar brass band performance this year on Tuesday, 11th July, 2017 (Upper School) and Wednesday, 12th July, 2017 (Lower School) – we hope that all the school children and staff members enjoy this year's event as much as they did last year's.

LOCAL PROJECTS:

There are a number of local projects within the village that Councillors are planning to support, we would welcome and encourage participations from all local (young and old) residents – regular reviews/updates to be help at the Partnership meeting

PARKING: To stimulate increased footfall at the local shops and businesses, improvements for access/parking in and around the village is to be developed/progressed.

YOUTH CLUB: Following the withdrawal of finance by Durham County Council for the Leadgate Youth Club (based in the 'Tute'), alternative grant funding to develop this facility into a 'Community Hub' is being sought – additional/new trustees will be required.

ENVIRONMENT:

Installation of a permanent electricity supply at the 'Gap Site' to support future Christmas Festivities (e.g. Christmas trees lights etc.) is to be progressed.

Improvement (seating, parking, flower tubs) have started at the site adjacent to the Doctors' Surgery. Consideration is being given to installation of bench seating, flower tubs, notice board, at the site at the open area next to the cricket field/opposite the new units on the old Store site.

We would hope that everyone will support these potential developments and we look forward to working with all interested stakeholders and the respective local organisations – Leadgate Ward Partnership and Leadgate Taskforce.
